ALLIANCE PAYMENT / REIMBURSEMENT FOR TRADE SCHOOL:



The Alliance will pay the Trade School administration fee for apprentices attending George Brown College or Humber College. The Alliance will reimburse Trade School administration fee for apprentices attending all other Community Colleges when a receipt of payment is provided as proof to the Alliance (\$500).

EMPLOYMENT INSURANCE

This would be available to you because you are attending school for training. E.l. provides temporary financial assistance for unemployed Canadians while they look for work or upgrade their skills. Apply through the College when attending Trade School.

IBEW SUPPLEMENTARY FUND

Equivalent to \$ 150.00 per week for apprentices who have worked a minimum of 1800 hours. An application to determine eligibility must be completed through the offices of IBEW LU353.

BOOKS FOR LOAN

Apprentices may borrow from the Alliance for use at Trade School (only 3 standard texts available where applicable).

APPRENTICESHIP INCENTIVE GRANT (AIG)

The AIG is a taxable cash grant of \$1,000 per year for registered apprentices once they have successfully completed their first or second year/level (or equivalent) of an apprenticeship program in one of the Red Seal trades.

Available through Service Canada.

TRADE SCHOOL BURSARIES

Upon successful completion of each level of Trade School, apprentices may apply for a \$500 bursary from the Alliance with the submission of their trade school transcript.

CERTIFICATE OF QUALIFICATION COMPLETION AWARD

Apprentices can receive a \$750 award for passing the C of Q exam on their first attempt. Available through the Alliance from the Greater Toronto E.C.A. Apprentices who pass the C of Q with a mark of 80% or higher will receive an additional \$400.

APPRENTICESHIP COMPLETION GRANT

A \$2,000 taxable cash grant for apprentices who complete their apprenticeship training and obtain Red Seal endorsement or a Provincial or Territorial Certificate of Qualification. Available through Service Canada.
